

51+ PARKS CHALLENGE

Following on from the success of the 50+ Peaks Challenge, which celebrated the 50th Anniversary of the establishment of the Springwood Bushwalking Club, the **51+ Parks Challenge** provides an optional theme for walks for the following year.

The rules are very simple:

- 1. The walks may be conducted in a national park, nature reserve, state conservation area (or similar) anywhere in the world.
- 2. The walks must be part of an approved SBC program activity.
- It's difficult to be specific about the nature of the walk, but some reasonable effort should be involved! A 10 minute stoll is not acceptable - generally it should be at least a half day activity. Multi-day walks are welcome. The walks may be on or off track.
- 4. The walks should take place between 19th April 2017 (the 50th Anniversary of the establishment of the Club) and the 18th April 2018.
- 5. Only the first walk in any park in this timeframe will be recognised.
- 6. If more than 50 parks are claimed all the better!!

To be eligible the leader, should forward the following information to: info@springwoodbushwalker.org.au

- 1. The name of the park, and its location.
- 2. The name of the walk (if it has one!).
- 3. A brief description of the day (3-4 sentences).
- 4. The date/s of the walk.
- 5. The name of the leader/s, and the names of all people in the party.
- 6. A digital photo of members of the party on the walk (square format preferred).

A powerpoint presentation on the walks will be made at a Club meeting in mid 2018, and prizes will be awarded for significant achievements.

The photographs and reports will also be used on the club website and Facebook page.
